



Secured \$460,788 (excluding the Oregon Data Suite) in external funding; \$360,786 in internal funding; and \$914,403 in Oregon Data Suite funding (shared with technology).

Provided survey development, data analysis, and program evaluation services directly to 16 WESD school districts and one non-WESD school district.

Provided Oregon Data Suite technical assistance and training to 92 school districts.



Awarded a **Grow Your Own** grant through Oregon Department of Education competitive proposal process in collaboration with 15 WESD school districts, Chemeketa Community College and Western Oregon University.



In collaboration with the Communications team and Willamette Promise staff, launched [Shape Oregon's Future: Become A Teacher](#) website outlining pathways for high school students, paraeducators, and career changers to pursue becoming licensed educators. Additionally, we were able to create videos with accompanying resources focusing on bilingual educators, indigenous educators, and a focus on the importance of understanding ethnicity for educators.



Developed 59 individual surveys addressing parent/student/staff comfort with returning to school, school resource officers, teacher mentoring, kindergarten transition, paraeducators, charter school alumni and parent perceptions, Oregon Data Suite feedback, school district organizational health, and end-of-year customer satisfaction.



Center staff analyzed over 11,810 individual respondent's survey responses including over 10,000 open-ended responses.

Center staff provided a weekly web-based dashboard highlighting statewide *Ready Schools, Safe Learners (RSSL)* school reopening metrics for every Oregon school district throughout the 2020-2021 school year.



Provided program evaluation and data analysis for *Columbia Gorge Regional Educator Network* and *SouthCoast 2 Valley Regional Educator Network* assisting both projects in monitoring and analyzing progress toward meeting annual goals.



Provided program evaluation services to *Western Oregon University's Teacher Pathways Grow Your Own* grant-funded program.



Assisted Dallas Community School in community engagement and initial development of a strategic plan including the establishment of a high school and K-12 accreditation.



Willamette ESD Projects

- In collaboration with the Communications team and the Willamette Promise staff, assisted with the production of 71 infographics highlighting the success of Willamette Promise students within the districts and individual schools

2021 - 2022 Goals

- 1) Assist districts with monitoring and analyzing students' "unfinished learning" using an equity lens.

METRICS:

- 100% of districts using ODS have dashboards to address students' unfinished learning
 - 100% of districts are able to review focal student populations using the ODS
- At least 50% of WESD districts purchasing Data Teams implement with fidelity
- Center staff develop and implement Data Teams protocol which includes fidelity checks, student progress monitoring overall and among focal student populations

- 2) Promote and support the Oregon Data Suite throughout Oregon.

METRICS:

- 90% of ODS customers requesting assistance report satisfaction with support/help requests
- 99% of ODS customer report satisfaction with ODS during end of year survey
- 100% of ODS districts receive personalized outreach yearly (e.g., phone call, email)
- ODS newsletter shared monthly August - June with all ODS districts
- Within WESD region, 100% of ODS districts use the ODS on a regular basis (i.e., monthly).

- 3) Promote and provide Center services throughout Oregon.

METRICS:

- Increase by 10% the number of districts using Center services in WESD
- Continue to provide Center services to three (3) districts outside of WESD region
- Continue to provide Center services to three (3) entities throughout Oregon
- 90% WESD districts report satisfaction with Center services during end-of-year survey

- 4) Provide Center services to WESD projects.

METRICS:

- Willamette Promise
 - Center successfully delivers 100% of the services in our MOU (as delineated or revised)
 - Center conducts a what works well and what didn't work process at least once/year with internal partners
 - CFEIA
 - Center successfully delivers 100% of the services in our MOU (as delineated or revised)
 - Center conducts a what works well and what didn't work process at least once/year with internal partners
- 5) Provide South Coast 2 Valley Regional Educator Network (SC2V REN) services to districts within the region

8. Develop systematic measurement for all Center services.

METRICS:

- Incorporate generic CFEIA survey into Center practice 100% of the time for projects.
 - Develop criteria for implementation
- Incorporate 3-question consultation survey into consultations.
 - Develop criteria for implementation
- Monitor ongoing feedback at quarterly intervals
