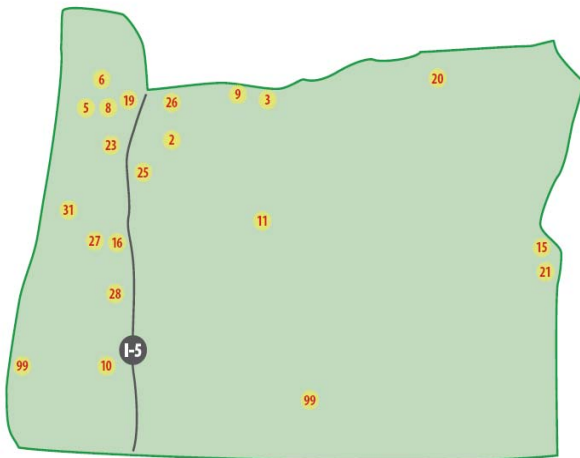


# Migrant Education in Oregon

During the regular school year, Oregon's numerous migrant education projects operate in support of and in coordination with the regular school program. During the summer at the peak of Oregon's harvesting season, educational programs are set up exclusively for migrant children since regular school programs are not in operation.

## PURPOSE

The Oregon Migrant Education Service Center (OMESC) is the educational support agency of the Oregon Department of Education's (ODE) Migrant Education Office. It serves as an umbrella organization to ODE's Migrant Education Office in coordinating services to the regional Oregon projects funded under Title I, Part C of ESSA.



## OMESC OBJECTIVES

- To assist school districts in meeting the needs of eligible migrant students.
- Functions as the statewide training and technical assistance center for Oregon Migrant Education Program (OMEP) staff.
- Provides professional development for all migrant education staff.
- Function as a liaison with other agencies in providing services to migrant children.
